Ordinance No. 27 Seventh City Council of Taguig Legislative Year 2023

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 06, SERIES OF 2012, PRESCRIBING FIXED PASSENGER FARES FOR MOTORIZED TRICYCLES FOR HIRE PLYING WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF TAGUIG AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATORS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991" mandates that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, through the Land Transportation Office (LTO), subject to the guidelines prescribed by the Department of Transportation and Communications, the Sangguniang Panlungsod is empowered under Section 447 of the Local Government Code to regulate the operation of motorized tricycles for hire within the territorial jurisdiction of Taguig;

WHEREAS, the prevailing minimum fare for passengers in the City of Taguig is Eight Pesos (PHP 8.00) for the 1st kilometer and an additional Fifty Centavos (0.50¢) for

WHEREAS, the City Government of Taguig finds it necessary to increase the fare of tricycle-for-hire for the members of Taguig City Tricycle Operators and Drivers and to adapt to the fluctuating or very unpredictable rise of the price of gasoline and goods.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Taguig, in session duly assembled and with quorum, that:;

SECTION 1. Fare Rates. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 06, series of 2012, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Regular Trips

every one kilometer thereafter;

Fixed rate of Twelve Pesos (PHP 12.00) for the 1<sup>st</sup> kilometer.

An additional One Peso (PHP 1.00) will be added for every kilometer.

Special Trips shall be upon the internal arrangement between the driver and passenger as regards the fare for special trips, provided that;

> 1. It will not be over the total amount of fares of the total number of passerngers allowed for every tricycle.

> 2. It will not affect other TODA Operators within the area where the special trip may be passing through and shall not be allowed to pick up passenger/s out of their route.

SECTION 2. Discount. A twenty per cent (20%) discount shall be deducted for Senior Citizens (SC), Persons with Disabilities (PWDs), and learners from elementary school to college, excluding graduate school and training centers.

SECTION 3. Penalties. Any person found violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be penalized, to wit:

First Offense

(PHP 1,000.00) A fine of One Thousand Pesos

Second Offense

A fine of Three Thousand Pesos (PHP 3,000.00)

Third Offense

A fine of Five Thousand Pesos

(PHP 5,000.00) and

revocation of Tricycle Franchise

SECTION 4. Fare Matrix Guide. The City Tricycle Franchising and Regulatory Board shall issue a fare matrix guide or "taripa" for specific routes within the City of Taguig. The fare matrix guide shall be posted conspicuously in all tricycle terminals and should be placed inside the sidecar of the tricycle unit.

SECTION 5. Repealing Clause. All other ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders, rules and regulations or any provisions thereof that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. Separability Clause. Should any provision of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by competent authority of court, other provisions not affected thereby shall be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. Effectivity Clause. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and general circulation and publication.
