WHEREAS, Section 458 (1) (viii) of Republic Act No. 7160 (Local Government Code) empowers the Sanguniang Panlungsod to determine the positions and the salaries, wages, allowances and other emoluments and benefits of officials and employees paid wholly or mainly from city funds and provide for expenditures necessary for the proper conduct of programs, projects, services, and activities of the city government;

WHEREAS, Section 12, Article VII of Commission on Higher Education (CHED) Memorandum Order No. 32 (Series of 2006) provides that the Governing Board (GB) of the University or Pamantasan as its policy-making body shall be called its Board of Regents (BOR);

WHEREAS, the Taguig City University (TCU) is governed by the Board of Regents (BOR) and CHED regulations pursuant to its academic programs and policies;

WHEREAS, the grant of honorarium constitutes a gesture/token of appreciation for the services of one with the expertise of professional standing and is given not as a matter of legal obligation but as appreciation of services which admit no compensation for that matter;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED, AS IT IS HEREBY ENACTED, by the 7th City Council of Taguig in a regular session duly assembled and with quorum, decrees that:

SECTION 1. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 29 (Series of 2004) is hereby amended and shall be read as follows:

Section 6. The amount of Five Thousand Pesos (Php 5,000.00) shall be the honorarium of the members of the Board for every attendance in Board meetings (including online platforms) actually attended but not to exceed four (4) paid meetings in a month subject to availability of funds and the usual accounting, and auditing laws, rules, and regulations.

SECTION 2. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other sections or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Repealing Clause. Any existing ordinance, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, which are contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby deemed repealed, revoked, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. Effectivity Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and publication of general circulation.
